His uncle runs an unorganized shop (Thela) of Panipuri and temporary shops of crackers, flowers, during festive seasons. He studied four years in Abhiyan (Bharat) Foundation school and moved to another school for further studies after passing 8 board exam in A grade. He was one of the good student who always performed well in all arena. As he grew, a feeling of self-respect developed in him. Now, Sometimes he works at fast-food shop in evening to meet his education needs and support his uncle. Her teacher suggested him no to work and focus on education but he says "my father sends school fees only, but other expenses are there on my education. I feel very hard when I see my uncle bearing all my living expenses. I am not going to work on daily basis. Whenever I feel scarcity of money, I go at fast food shop to work. I think if I can earn little, I can bear by at least. This will expenses be contribution to my family"
